Permission to reproduce figures, tables, and extended quotations must be obtained from the copyright holder (usually the publisher and the original author). Permission forms are available for this purpose from Springer. The source of any such reproduction must be always acknowledged.

Please make sure that the manuscript is in its final form, since no extensive changes in the proofs are possible. The corrections in the proofs should be limited to printing errors.

The title page should include:

- title of contribution
- first names (or initials) and last names of all authors
- department, institution, city zip code, country, telephone and fax numbers, e-mail
- any footnotes referring to the title

Manuscripts, written in **English**, are subject to copyediting and will, if necessary, be returned to the authors/editors for questions to be answered.
